NEWS AND INFORMATION UPDATES

The directors have been busy over the winter and spring preparing for the upcoming season. Please review the following information to be aware of changes and updates:

- Our net pen was again a success under the management of Jeremy Maynard. Thanks to all the volunteers who gave their time.
- The Operator License for Pleasure Craft is required for operators of Tye rowboats with a motor or you will risk a fine of \$250.
- Yearbooks are again available at the clubhouse or upon request by emailing president@tyeclub.com. We are looking for some volunteers to undertake the production of another edition.
- Nominations for the board are open and can be sent to nominations@tyeclub.org. Please consider putting your name forward.
- The website is the place to go for information and members are encouraged to check frequently for updates, contact information or forms. www.tyeclub.org Pictures are available for downloading usually the same day a fish is registered.
- Please support our raffles and fundraisers again this year. We have some great prizes to give away and these funds go to support ongoing costs of maintaining the clubhouse and the operations of the club. Tickets are available at the clubhouse or at River Sportsman.
- The clubhouse has been a wonderful gathering place and is open for the season, with the coffee pot always on.
- Our weigh masters, Bing and Francis are ready for another season. Please note we have a dedicated telephone line with voicemail at the clubhouse during the season. The telephone number is 250-914-4455.
- Please note the Calendar of events. Everyone is welcome at these events.
- Due to the increased number of boats on the water the directors remain concerned about the number of incidents happening involving motors in the pool, not having motors up when fishing, following correct protocol when travelling, not yelling "Fish On" at the first opportunity, not bringing lines up to allow boats to move out of the pool, self guided boats not moving out of the pool and other violations of our Rules & Regulations as outlined in the Tye Club Yearbook. We had 8 rookie rowers last season in addition to many others who were not lucky enough to claim that honour, so we all must take a role in education to ensure everyone is able to participate without incident. It is in all of our best interests to help those who are new rowers to learn.
- If you have a protest, please contact a director and put your protest in writing within 24 hours. This is the only way that any action may commence regarding an incident on the water.
- Last season we gained permission to place borrowed floats at our normal location to get us through the season. Further developments over the winter have moved us closer to a rebuild of our wharves. After working through City,

Provincial and Federal governments, to get the necessary approvals, we believe we are close to being granted permits for the necessary work. The work will take about 3 days and we hope to commence the first week of August. Until then we have been informed that we are not able to do any work or occupy the wharves. This is creating a very difficult situation; however, I can assure you that everything possible is being done. There have been many people involved in this process, both as advisors and donors. We are working through a process and those that occupy spaces on the wharf have been contacted and informed about the situation in more detail.

- Please let us know if you have a spare seat to take someone fishing. We have several people that support the club and all they ask in return, is to be taken out for a tide. It would be greatly appreciated. Leave your name at the clubhouse.
