

NOMINATING COMMITTEE 2023 UPDATE

The Nominating Committee's role is to accept nominations for Tyee Club directors. Monitoring length of terms for incumbent directors is also required.

To be nominated for a director, one must be a member of the Tyee Club. Two existing members need to sign for the person who wishes to be a director. There are currently 12 directors on the Tyee Club board. The Tyee Club bylaws will allow up to 15 directors so there are 3 available spots if someone is interested in being a director. A director nomination form is available on the Tyee Club website.

Applications for director nomination must be received a minimum 2 weeks before the AGM that occurs the third Saturday of August every year. The nomination(s) will be presented at the AGM and those members in attendance will vote on the proposed nomination.

Length of term for a director is 3 years. Directors are expected to be involved in 1 or more committees to help other directors with the volunteer work that is necessary to help the Tyee Club run efficiently.

There are many committees in the Tyee Club that manage different areas of responsibility that help the Tyee Club function smoothly 12 months a year. An individual doesn't have to be a registered member to be involved in a committee.

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
